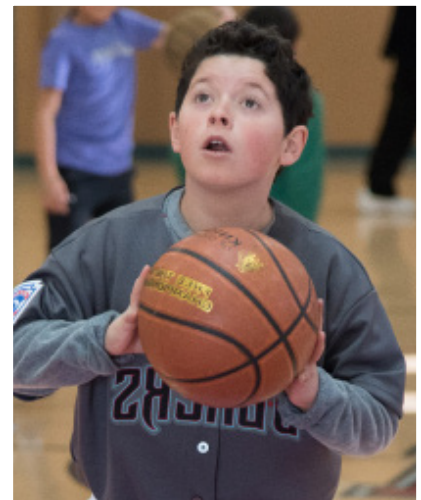
In addition to hospitality, Ben also attends our various Knights functions to come and help. We love having Ben join us as one of the crew.

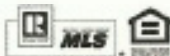

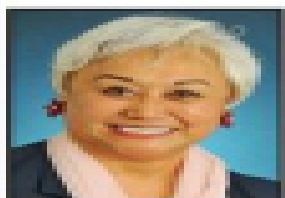
