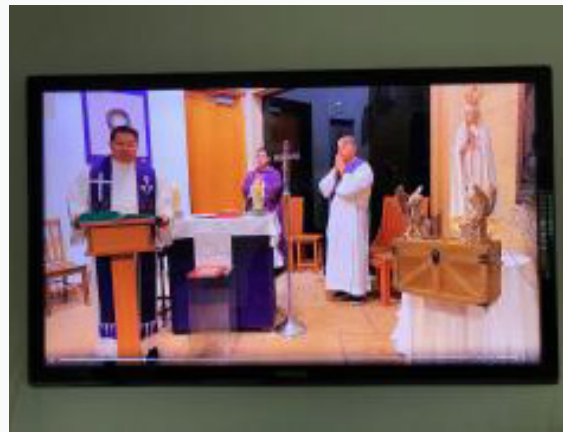
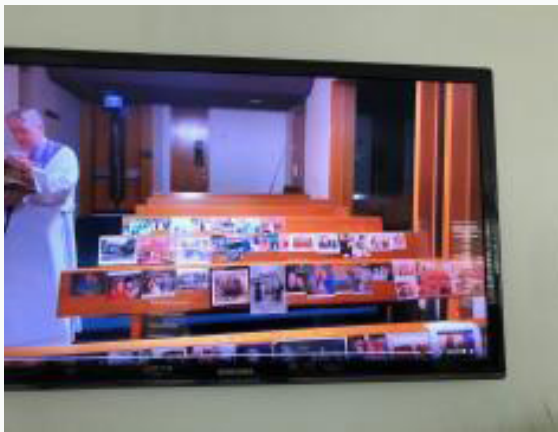


Next Recycle WEEKEND: **Saturday, April 11**
