District Deputy's Corner

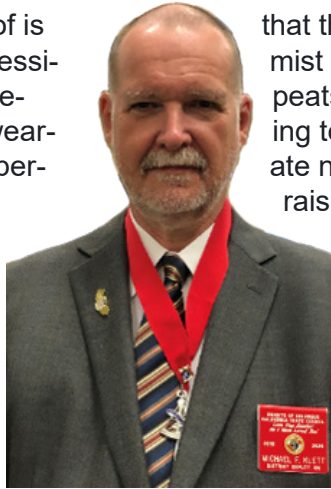
