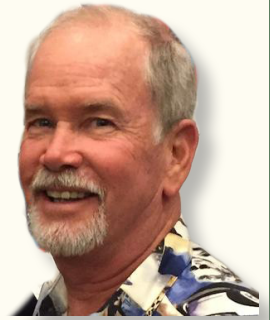

# Grand Knight's Report



## Brother Knights,

Our check for the Ultrasound machine has been sent to Refuge Pregnancy Center, Indio, CA. The device will arrive the week of May 8th. I will keep you up to date on any events surrounding the delivery.

We Successfully hosted the 2022 Clergy Night on February 18<sup>th</sup>, approximately 20 days after the originally scheduled date. The event, held in the SDC parish hall, easily accommodated 350+ brother knights and clergy of the Orange Chapter.

The following Saturday in the very same SDC Parish Hall Our 1st Annual "Founders Luncheon" was held. The idea was proposed by our Deputy Grand Knight, John Teeter, served 70 of our 9487 alumni. The entire event was catered in house by our unofficial "Ladies Auxiliary." Thank You to everyone involved!

The Food Drive had another successful drive. Overall 4000lbs of food was collected.

The following is a message from our Supreme Knight:

*The situation in Ukraine is dire and worsening. The people of Ukraine, and our brother Knights and their families in that nation, need our help.*

*I call upon all Knights to join me in praying for peace in Ukraine, and especially for the safety of our more than 1,800 brother Knights and their families who suddenly face the danger of war. Please also join me in responding to the recent [appeal](#) of Pope Francis to join him in prayer and fasting for Ukraine on Ash Wednesday, March 2.*

*In addition to our prayers, the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council has committed \$1.5 million for immediate distribution to support Ukrainian refugees, including Ukrainian Knights and their families. We will be working with our councils in Poland as well as the Latin and Greek Catholic Churches in Ukraine to provide humanitarian assistance.*

My Brothers, this issue hits close to home for my wife and I. Both Our family origins have Ukrainian roots.

Here is another way we can help:

Knights of Columbus Charities has launched the Ukraine Solidarity Fund for this purpose, and the Supreme Council will match all funds up to \$500,000. ## District Deputy's Corner

### **Worthy Brothers,**

The month is March. This means several things to us. Lent is beginning on Ash Wednesday. The Annual State Meeting (aka The State Convention) is quickly approaching. We are getting close to the end of the Columbian year. There are more things that March will mean to each of you individually.

The delegates for the Annual State Meeting need to be submitted very soon. The delegates need to be voted on by the council. One delegate is known as the "Grand Knight Delegate" and the other is known as the "Past Grand Knight Delegate". I encourage the Current Grand Knight and the Immediate Past Grand Knight to take these two positions. There also alternates for each delegate. I encourage the Deputy Grand Knight to be the alternate for the Grand Knight Delegate and any Past Grand Knight to be the alternate Past Grand Knight Delegate. I also encourage the council to put up a stipend for a portion of all four brothers' expenses. I have heard that the convention area is small and State is requesting that one of the delegates attend the convention in person and the other to attend online. If you do go to the Annual State Meeting, be sure to stop by the Orange Chapter Hospitality Booth and see where some of your Chapter Per Capita is being spent.

It is also approaching the time of annual officer elections. Article II Section 1 of the bylaws state:

***"The annual election of officers shall take place at a regular meeting held between (Not less than two months Grand Knight shall appoint three who shall prepare a tentative council offices. This council not later than the meeting at which place. Other nominations nominations may not be has convened and the members are ready to ballot.)"***

I encourage the Deputy Grand Knight as the Grand Knight Apparent to head up the nominating committee and I encourage all of the 3rd Degree brothers of the council to prayerfully consider becoming an officer and let the Deputy Grand Knight know that they are willing to serve.

Let me tell you why I became an officer and eventually a District Deputy. Hear my "why" and consider your own "why". Many years ago, I was not yet a 3rd Degree Knight. But one day I was praying and considering my life. I realized that one day I was going to die and that day I would have a conversation with our Lord. I imagined that he would ask me to tell him what I had done on earth (not that he needed to hear it from me as he already knew everything about me, but I imagine him as being very polite). At that time, I would be able to tell him about how I had fought for motorcycle rights and the 2nd Amendment. # FOUNDERS' LUNCHEON

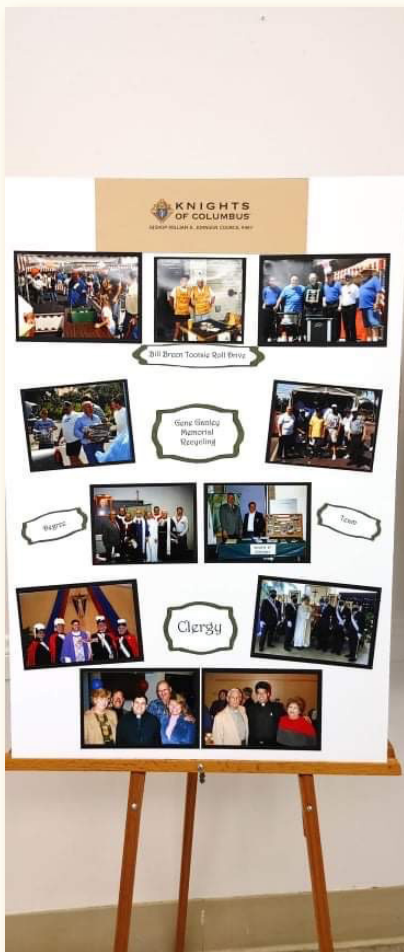
