His wife, Pamela Pham was a cradle Catholic, but not particularly devout. They have been parishioners here since basically when the church was founded, having lived in Lake Forest continuously since their marriage in 1992. Bob was not Catholic, not truly even Christian, but came with his wife and his family to Mass every Christmas, and an occasional other time. Bob came to Christ just over 3 years ago, and joined the Catholic Church just over 2 years ago. He became Catholic because after long prayerful study, he determined that this was indeed the Church Jesus promised the gates of hell would not stand against. It seemed difficult at first: "Well, not I am a Christian, so which of the 1000 flavors of Christianity is the right one for me?" Bob loves the honest and loving dedication of his brother knights to serving others. He thinks it is a magnificent organization overall. Sure, he could see areas it could use improvement. He hopes to contribute in the future in many ways to make it even better.

Our knight of the month participated in the festival, in the blood drive, and helped pass out books before and after Mass. He loves to help when he can, but also sensitive to over-committing himself. 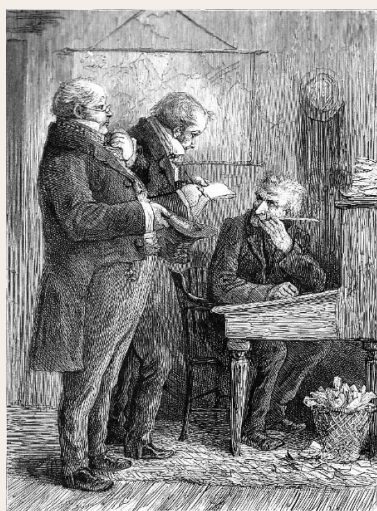
