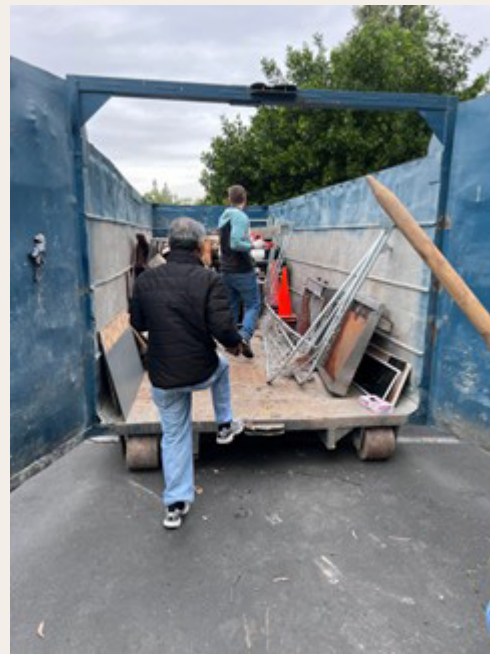

KNIGHTS PARTICIPATING IN WELCOME RETREATS

Knights of Columbus Participating in The Welcome Retreat Ministry

Almost four years ago our Parish Director of Ministries approached Brother Ron Fernandez and asked him if he would take on the role of Being the Formation Leader for a new ministry called Welcome Retreat for Men. Over a 5 to 6 month time frame, a team meets at least once a week to prepare for and plan the retreat. Father Thomas best summed up the purpose of this ministry in his January 22, 2023 parish bulletin letter as “an opportunity to deepen and renew their relationship with God our Loving Father. It is an occasion to commit themselves as intentional Christian disciples and stewards.”

The retreat occurs over a Saturday and Sunday and includes attending Saturday 8am Mass, a breakfast, hearing witnesses from Welcome Retreat team members, small group discussions, a lunch, group prayer, a 5 star dinner experience and participating in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and it closes with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The men go home Saturday night and return Sunday morning for breakfast, more witnesses and small group discussions. The Welcome Retreat team and attendees then have a private Mass that as PGK brother Bob Kupfert said, “Feels like literally being at the Last Supper.” The retreat participants then partake in a lunch and afterward some further spiritual activities.

I do not wish to go into too much detail about the retreat except to say that the experience was, for me, one of the best things I have ever participated in for deepening my faith, and I have heard the same reaction from most who have attended. (The meals are all outstanding as well!)

Less than 2 weeks before the first men's Welcome Retreat was to take place the pandemic shut down occurred and the retreat was put on hold. Finally, on November 6th and 7th 2021, the 1st Men's Welcome Retreat occurred. Brother Ron Fernandez, the formation leader had recruited a team which included several fellow brother knights including: Retreat leader Dave Stokes, Jerry Clements, John Freeman, Edmund Del Rosario, Vlad Burce, Mark Dy-Ragos, Dennis Fung, PGK Mike Sofka, and Ricardo Teano. Most of those who attended the retreat were Knights as well.

The ministry is built on a carry it forward principle and those who attend the re
