# Grand Knight's Report

**B**rothers All,

We are nearly done with three quarters of the Columbian Year, 22/23. Time has really flown by, but we have accomplished quite a bit. I have highlighted some of them below.

On the recruiting side, We are well over annual target. Due in large part to the recruiting efforts of Ricardo Teano, we have exceeded our Target of 15 new members. In fact the last exemplification had 16 new Knights, who we are honoring with a reception dinner prior to the March 1st Dinner at 5:30 on the pavilion before our meeting. The Meeting will begin at 8 PM so we can have a bit of time to socialize.

We have moved forward on our "spend down" plan which was designed to reduce excess general accounts funds to an acceptable level for a 501c tax exempt organization. We have committed funds to purchase two Digital Display sign boards to be used to post information about upcoming events, special parish news etc. The Equipment should be ordered early in March for delivery in April or May.

We have cancelled our traditional casino night, and given our time slot to Chapter who will be holding an Orange County Wide Texas Hold 'em Tournament on March 11th. If you are interested in participating the entry fee is \$75, for more information, or you can sign up, by calling either Mike Ulibarri at (310) 721-9160 or Vince Vasquez at (949) 207-4085.

We finalized our Collections for the Intellectually Disabled Drive this past weekend on the plaza where, with the help of dozens of knights, we were able to exceed the \$18,500 mark. This money will be targeted to provide those in the most need of our support. This year's donations will be donated to Shea's Riding Center, and Orange County Special Olympics.

Council 9487 was the recipient of a very generous gift from our Brother, Ken Allen. This will be used to increase our scholarships for children and grandchildren of knights who attend Catholic Schools. Those who are interested can submit an essay titled, "***Why I Value a Catholic Education.***" Submission should go to our council C/O Clete Menke, Chairman. Deliver them to the parish office in an envelope for consideration before April 30th. The Scholarship Committee will evaluate applications and checks will be released in June.

In the final quarter, we hope to secure facilities to hold two or three Fundraiser Events. We will reignite the Burger Bash, schedule a Spaghetti Dinner with profits targeted to go to the SDC Childrens' Religious Education, and help run a Car Wash with the Youth Group.

## KNIGHTS PARTICIPATING IN ST VINCENT DE PAUL MINISTRY

The Knights of Columbus have 4 principles that guide us in all of our activities. They are charity, unity, fraternity, and patriotism. The principle of charity is practiced by our council through many activities such as the ID drive, education scholarships, pro life activities, the food drive and many more activities that our council participates in.

There is a parish ministry that is also dedicated to works of charity: The St. Vincent de Paul Society. The objective of this ministry is to lead women and men to join together and grow spiritually by offering person to person services to the needy and suffering.

Our brother Julio Martinez was driving to work one morning when he had a thought, "why doesn't our parish have a St. Vincent de Paul Society?" He contacted the SVDP at the diocesan level to see what it would take to have the ministry at our parish then took his findings to our pastor at that time, Fr. Ken Smit. Fr. Ken agreed that this would be a great ministry for our parish to have. This was in 1996. Brother Julio says it was clearly an example of Divine Providence at work.

Brother Dennis Fung is currently the Vice President of the SVDP ministry. He joined this ministry in the early days of the pandemic. His career work in law enforcement had been guided by the theory that the individual is 100% responsible for the circumstances they find themselves in. It is their choices and decisions that put them in these circumstances. Brother Dennis saw that events can happen that you have no control over and can put you in circumstances that can be dire and not within one's control. He says that working in this ministry has helped him be more empathetic towards others.

Our SVDP ministry works with parishioners who are in need of help with life necessities such as money for rent, utilities, groceries, gasoline, and auto repairs. They also work with other Lake Forest residents and partner with other south orange county parishes. It is important to note that all of those who receive help through our parish SVDP ministry are local South Orange County people. The philosophy of this is ministry is, "they give a hand up not a hand out."

The ministry receives on average 2 to 3 calls a week for help. Each call is assigned to a case worker and there are about 10 ongoing cases at any one time. Brother Julio is one of the case workers for the ministry.

The current President of the Ministry is Grant Stockton. Dennis Fung is Vice President. The spouses of some of our brothers including Mary Ojeda (PGK John) and Golda Kattapuram ( Brother James) are also officers.

Every month with a 5th Sunday we conduct a collection for the St. Vincent de Paul Society. Additionally, our council has given several black box collections from the monthly meetings to this ministry. As we are called on during this lenten season to increase our alms giving perhaps you might consider giving to this worthy ministry, which helps our local neighbors in need. Thank you to the Knights and spouses of Knights who donate their time, talents, and treasures to the St. Vincent de Paul Ministry.
