### **CATHOLIC MEN'S FELLOWSHIP MINISTRY**

The Catholic Men's Fellowship Ministry has been a ministry at our parish since the parish was established. The current format of this ministry, however, is about 9 years old according to Brother Knight Ron Fernandez.

Every Saturday from 7AM to 7:55AM a group of men including several K of C council 9487 members from our parish meet in the Santiago Room of the parish hall. Usually between 8 to 14 men gather together. The ministry is actually open to all Catholic men, not just parishioners of Santiago De Compostela. Each meeting starts with the reading of the upcoming Sunday's Gospel. That is where the meeting structure or agenda ends.

The men may discuss the meaning of the Gospel reading which is usually what happens first. The discussion may go from the Gospel to any spiritual subject those present want to discuss. Oftentimes, prayer intentions are asked for, life issues that participants are experiencing are discussed, or whatever spiritual topics are relevant to those in attendance. The participants then attend the 8AM Saturday mass.

In preparing to write this article I attended the March 18th meeting. After discussing the Gospel reading and ways we can be spiritually blind the discussion moved towards talking about our own mortality and appreciating each day as the gift from God that it is. I realized what a blessing this ministry truly is, and what came to mind was Jesus' words, "when two or more are gathered in my name I am there among them." *Matthew* 18:20.

Before the pandemic the ministry would have a quarterly meeting, on a Saturday at 9AM, with a guest speaker followed by breaking down into small groups for discussions. These quarterly meetings will most likely be reinstated in the near future. During the pandemic this ministry was carried on by having Zoom meetings but have now returned to in person meetings.

This ministry is truly a blessing, and I would encourage all my brothers to attend a meeting. Again, they are held every Saturday at 7AM in The Santiago Room of the parish hall. You will be welcomed by many other council 9487 members.
