Do I have a story for you about Kiet and his spiritual journey. But first let us congratulate him on his splendid achievement earning this award. Congratulations Kiet and to your family.

Kiet is a convert, a 3rd degree knight for a year now and on his wonderful way to the 4th degree of full knighthood next month.

It all started when he was dropping off food donations for South County Outreach and was greeted by men in green shirts collecting and sorting dry food goods. A guy named Ricardo, who has been recruiting him for 8 years, ap-

proached him and this time he felt his true calling and joined.

His wife Minh was raised Catholic and Kiet was raised Buddhist. He converted and became a Catholic in April, 2004. They were married at St John the Baptist Church in Costa Mesa, CA. Their two daughters have been raised in the Catholic Faith since they were newborns. Minh and Kiet are both first generation Southeast Asians of Vietnamese and Chinese descent, born in Saigon, Vietnam. Their families escaped Vietnam in the late 70s. Kiet is an Operations and Logistics Professional in the Real Estate Mortgage Industry and Minh is a stay-at-home mom managing domestic duties to keep their house, he said from falling apart from the inside.

They have two beautiful daughters, Maddi and Sammi, 18 and 14 respectively. Maddi is a music major in college and Sammi just started her freshman year in high school. They all enjoy playing music at home with their piano, guitars, and ukeleles.

Let us see what Kiet has done in his first year as a Santiago Knight:

**Recycling Ministry:** He assists in the Monday morning recycling, working as a sorter at the barn or as a walker to help collect recyclables in the driveways of participating mobile home communities.

**South County Outreach Food Drive Ministry:** He assisted in receiving donations and sorting them when we used to sort dry goods ready for our County Outreach partner. Now he helps empty the blue donation bins in front of the church whenever they get full.

**Parish Cleanup Ministry:** He assisted in the last two weekend parish cleanups to help maintain our church and surrounding areas.

**Orange County Walk of Life:** He attended with our fraternal brothers to provide support for the O.C. Walk of Life and assisted in handing out posters and directing the Pro-Life procession at the Christ Cathedral.

*Festival and Function Setups:* He assisted with parish setups for Spaghetti dinners, pavilion setup for Father Martin's going away, and for the 2023 Camino Santiago.

*Monthly Council Meetings:* He attended monthly KoFC meetings to keep up to date with Council 9487 activities and upcoming events.

Kiet is also currently volunteering in multiple ministries in our church as follows.

### **KIET WU (Continued)**

*Weekend Renewal Ministry:* He is the current Formation Leader for the upcoming Weekend Welcome Renewal 5, coming next March, 2024. This is our fifth Men's Retreat.

**Hospitality Ministry:** He is a Hospitality Team Member for the 12:00 PM Sunday Mass with maintaining Holy water fonts, ushering, collecting and protecting parishioner donations, and securitizing and protecting the Host.

*Altar Service Ministry:* He is an MC-in-training to help direct altar servers and is an active altar server himself. He assists when and where he is needed but mainly serves the 6:00 AM daily Mass.

*Christian in Commerce Ministry:* He attends the weekly CIC meetings that supports working Christians as we discuss, build, and nurture God's presence in the workplace.

The above list of volunteer work started out as just 1 day of the month sorting donated food, and exploded into various ministries that he genuinely enjoys. He likes to try new things and just help where he can. With personal commitment to just saying, "Yes" to God and KofC opening doors, he was able to get to know new parish families that he never would have the chance to meet. The humble soul of SDC parish resonated with them all.

"The Knights Brotherhood has opened many doors," he said, but he knows it is God's grace that keeps the door unlocked to allow us to do what we do. He further said he was in a bad place a year ago, but joining KofC gave him a renewed spirit and helped him redirect all that negative energy.

What a joyful story to hear. Having him as a brother knight is a gift.
