A WEEKEND SPENT IN FAITH BUILDING & BROTHERHOOD

This past March 9th and 10th the Renewal V weekend for Santiago De Compostela men was held. Thirty-one men attended this retreat weekend. At the end of the retreat each participant was asked to summarize the weekend in 1 word. The majority of the men involved in this ministry are brother Knights going back to the first weekend, (Welcome/Renew 1) which was led by Brother Ron Fernandez. Words do not adequately represent how powerful this ministry has been for those who have experienced the Welcome/Renew weekend. What I can say is that for me personally it has been one of best faith building activities I have ever participated in.

These weekends are offered about every 6 months at our parish. During the 6 months, between the retreat weekends, a team of men meet weekly for about 2 hours to prepare for the next retreat. There is also preparatory work done between the weekly meetings by the retreat leaders. It always evolves into a ministry that the team feels very passionate about. After the weekend the teams always agree that seeing the growth of the attendees during the weekend is beyond satisfying. It has been expressed by more than 1 team member that they could feel the Holy Spirit's presence throughout the weekend.

I am purposely not giving details about the weekend because it is the philosophy of the people who developed the weekend format that the attendees will get the most out of the weekend if they attend with no preconceptions, just an open mind and open heart.

Over 100 parish men have attended the 5 Welcome/Renew weekends but for those who have not yet attended please give serious consideration to attend Welcome/Renew VI. It is tentatively scheduled for late august. It is an experience you cannot afford to miss.

VIDA - FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION MINISTRY

The Volunteer Income Assistance Program (VITA) was relaunched at Santiago de Compostela Parish in 2022 through Father Thomas' initiative. Father Thomas asked Judith Clements (and of course she volunteered her husband, Jerry Clements to relaunch the program and coordinate bringing together volunteers.

The program offers FREE tax preparation and eFiling assistance to low-to-moderate income individuals, the elderly, persons with disabilities, and those with limited English-speaking abilities, not only in Santiago de Compostela Parish but also in the neighboring communities of Lake Forest.

Since its relaunch, the Santiago der Compostela VITA Ministry has grown from having just 7 active volunteers to now having 27 active volunteers, six of whom are Knights of Columbus.

The ministry has grown from 57 returns filed in 2022 to an estimated 250 returns filed by the end of the 2024 tax season, and \$11,000.00 contributed from the SDC VITA Ministry to the building fund



in 2023.

It takes a special person to become a VITA volunteer; not only are you asked to volunteer, but you also need to study and pass the test/certification. Different individuals coming together with one goal in mind: to dedicate their time and talent in service for the good of the community.
