Probably the highlight of the month was the Build-A-Bed project that was held on February 8th in our parking lot. We had over 50 Brother Knights and family members show up to help saw, drill, sand, stain and partially assemble 20 beds. The project was underwritten by Supreme who provide the \$5000 needed to purchase materials. This program is run by "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" which is a national group with over 300 chapters. Our Intellectual Disabilities, or better known as the ID Drive program, is winding up with our last event of the parish appeal that happened earlier in February. According to Chairperson Brother Mike Bynes, we are well on our way to exceeding previous years totals. After much discussion and investigation, we will strongly consider applying our funds directly to the chosen charities through our OC Knights Chapter instead of through the Frank Negro Columbian Foundation. The biggest benefit is that there is no loss of 7% of funds being diverted to overhead.

Our Council also had a very successful blood drive this month and hit our goal for donations. A special thank you to Jose Lopez who manned the sign-up sheet booth after all the Masses for two weekends.

A new event was also held in February with the assembly of food bags for the homeless. We were able to assemble 300 food bags of non-perishable items to be distributed to needy and homeless. Please see the newsletter article for more information.

Sleep in Heavenly Peace was started in 2012 by Luke and Heidi Mickelson in Twin Falls, Idaho and now has over 300 chapters in the U.S. and Canada. The goal is to make beds for kids



SDC Council was the last one to gain acceptance under this pilot program. Our efforts were supported by the San Diego Chapter of SHP which provided all the equipment, wood, saws, drills, staining baths, and associated hardware to make this happen. Over twenty people from the San Diego chapter showed up at 7:00 in the

morning to set up all the equipment and provide guidance for us. A barbeque lunch was served afterward to all the hard workers.

We received many very positive comments about this project and many expressed that this was one of the best activities we've done because it brought a lot of Brothers together, we were able to share the experience with other family members and it supported a good cause. The SHP people were great to work with and they have approached us afterwards to see if we can assist a chapter in Santa Ana to get up and going, as they are in the very early stage. This will be explored to see what our Council can do going forward.

ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL BLOOD DRIVE

On Tuesday February 18th our council hosted a blood drive, as we do 3 to 4 times a year, in partnership with the American Red Cross. 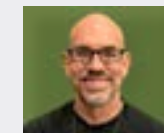

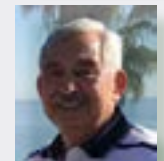
